



A Note to Directors:

Thanks for coming to Cavalcade! As we enter our 4th decade of hosting this show, we would like to thank all of you who come to join us year after year. It is our goal to provide the best possible venue and organization to allow the bands to present their performances. With that in mind, we would like to mention some items to help things run as smoothly as possible.

- 1) **Please avoid running over the volunteers.** We absolutely could not host Cavalcade without the efforts of a great number of student and adult volunteers. Many of these folks have not had students in our bands for years, but love the event and continue to offer their help. The “contact points” are especially critical. Barricade personnel, band guides and field organization folks are all working to make the event proceed smoothly. If there are issues, please contact one of the administrative staff and let us know. We will try to resolve them as quickly as possible.
- 2) **Please limit vehicles in the restricted areas.** One of the greatest issues we face is finding adequate parking and staging areas for all of the bands and their support vehicles. Please help us with this. In addition, if you are having food delivered to your group, plan to meet the delivery folks at the barricade. Pasco has an ideal spot to use where the street is blocked off at Henry and 14th. Once bands, guards and front ensembles start moving around, the area inside the barricades becomes quite congested. Once support vehicles leave, please do not have them reenter without checking with staff. If you need help, we will gladly have one of our support vehicles meet you to transport to your area.
- 3) **Please follow the guidelines for warm up and staging areas.** In Pasco, we have 3 churches and multiple neighborhoods in the vicinity of Edgar Brown Stadium. We will make every effort to accommodate your needs and requests, but the physical layout of our site does put some restrictions on what we can do. We are striving to meet the needs of the groups while being good neighbors.
